- Recommend statutory or regulatory changes needed to ensure occupational safety and health.

- Marketing targeted toward labor trade management and union memberships continues to result in "filled-to-capacity" participation in the OSHA Construction Outreach Track which produces a tangible certification that is recognized nationally, a 10-Hour Construction Card. This marketing also continues to produce a steady attendance in the Advanced Construction Safety Management Track.
