This request includes but is not limited to the following:

1 Funding for the UAF Institute of Artic Biology Logistics Facility. The current 1970 ATCO trailer that houses the IAB logistics office is structurally obsolete,

2 Funding for the Tanana Valley Campus Hutch Career Center Upgrade. This project involves revitalizing a 110,000 square foot building and adding 27,000 feet of new classrooms, shops and offices,

3 UAF Athletics Title IX Facility Modifications.
