Component: Assert/Protect State's Rights

Contribution to Department's Mission

This unit contributes to the department's mission by providing the opportunity to utilize fish and wildlife resources; providing information to all customers; and by protecting the state's sovereignty to manage fish and wildlife resources.

Core Services

The Alaska Native Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA) of 1980 is being implemented by federal agencies on 60% of Alaska's land. The public's rights of access and activities are being increasingly restricted by federal agencies, thereby taxing the resources of the department. Major activities under this component include the following:

- 1) Monitor federal land management plans, regulations, policies, and administrative actions;
- 2) Document traditional access in federal conservation system units (parks, refuges, etc.);
- 3) Intercede in commercial services permitting; and
- 4) Provide technical information for state assertion of ownership and management of navigable waters, filing of associated easements, and analysis of impacts of federal actions on public use and state management of fish and wildlife for the Department of Law.

Key Component Challenges

The key challenge of this unit is to assure the public's and department's rights of access and activities and state management of fish and wildlife on federal lands are not unduly restricted by federal agencies as they implement the Alaska Native Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA) of 1980.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2006

This unit will be expanded to identify and prioritize stae navigable waterways to apply for Recordable Disclaimer of Interests from the federal government to clear up ownership disputes. This unit will also identify historic routes and trails to assert state RS 2477right-of-ways in federal court.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2004

- Made revisions to federal refuge plans to prevent unnecessary restrictions on commercial services and access to hunting and fishing.
- Instrumental in making changes to national park policies regarding camping, access, food storage, and access to inholdings.
- Filed 12 applications for title to state navigable waterways.
- · Assisted in revisions to proposed Forest Service restrictions in wilderness areas on fish and game management
