Project Description/Justification:

After the Selendang Ayu grounding on Unalaska Island, Governor Murkowski asked the U.S. Coast Guard to lead an effort to assess the risk posed by the international North Pacific shipping lanes through the Aleutian Islands; stating that the state should play a major role in the development and conduct of this important assessment. The state, as a member of the steering committee, will help develop the scope of the assessment, select a consultant, and participate in determining future casualty and spill prevention measures.

The Coast Guard is willing to take the lead and to obtain and provide the majority of the projected total cost (estimated at 2.0 million). Requested funding, a small portion of the Coast Guard's actual cost, will be used to contribute toward the cost of a consultant to conduct the risk assessment and analyze the findings.
