9. Detailed project description and justification	 The Kaltag School heating system consists of a series of Sing air furnaces and draft inducer units. The Singer brand heating have reached their life expectancy. The system is now obsole because the company sold its heating division years ago parts difficult to acquire. The school also relied upon the village's recovered heat from power plant that was located next to the school. A new power was constructed in 2005 further away from the school; an attemade to utilize waste heat from the new power plant, but becathe distance, heat recovery was minimal. This caused a greate on the school's forced air heating units. The school's remote location, coupled with Kaltag's harsh wi underscore the need for a dependable heating system; reliabili remains a concern. During the fall of 2006, the heating system forcing the school to close for several days.
