FY2008 - \$2,100,000; FY2006 - \$976,000; FY2005 - \$6,971,250.

## **Project Description/Justification:**

The existing 2,700 foot by 35 foot airstrip is far below state and federal standards. The approaches are directly over the Manley roadhouse. The float plane facility approach conflicts with the runway approach. Additionally, the approaches and sides are obstructed by tall trees. There is no apron or taxiway, and over a dozen based aircraft park adjacent to the runway within the safety area and primary surface. There is no area available for lease lot development. Airport improvements are long overdue and the community has recently reached consensus on a relocation plan.
