Project Description/Justification:

Beginning in 2008, Southeast Region Highways and Aviation will assume maintenance responsibility for the 22 mile long Coffman Cove Highway. The closest established maintenance station is at Klawock, approximately 57 miles from Coffman Cove, and too far away to provide efficient maintenance service. A small maintenance station is needed in Coffman Cove with a plow truck and loader. The cost of a 100 x 40 square foot maintenance building is estimated at \$700,000: engineering and site preparation at \$80,000, right of way acquisition is estimated at \$200,000. The truck and loader are requested under a separate capital request.

This effort will support the Department's Mission End Results and Strategies of:

- Maintain State owned highways and airports to appropriate State standards.
- Keep statewide average cost per lane mile to maintain highways and airports at \$5,223.
