Project Description/Justification:

The Allakaket runway was constructed in 1997. However, the existing foundations included extensive permafrost and wet areas. Thaw-settlement has caused serious safety concerns due to differential settlement of the runway, embankment cracking along the fill slopes and safety areas, slope erosion, drainage problems and distress to the lighting system.

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
