**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**  
 This amendment to the FY2009 Governor's Budget adds \$5,000,000 in Federal Receipts for a new FY2009 total of \$11,900,000. The latest construction estimate for this project is \$37,000,000. Replace the Tanana River Bridge (#0505) at Milepost 1303 (near Tok) on the Alaska Highway. This project will also include realignment of approximately one mile of the Alaska Highway. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

 FY2008 - \$20,850,000; FY2007 - \$4,250,000 congressional earmark.

**Project Description/Justification:**  
 The existing structure is deficient in load bearing capacity and through truss clearances. This will provide replacement on the new stream alignment including bike lane and approach work. This project is an essential highway improvement for general mobility, and will facilitate the construction logistics of the Alaska Natural Gas Pipeline.
