Project Description/Justification:

This project will expand the vehicle staging area and the terminal building, replace the vehicle/pedestrian transfer bridge, and make security improvements. Adequate vehicle staging is needed to keep vehicles off the street. The existing terminal building is too small to accommodate existing traffic and future security requirements. The existing transfer bridge needs to be replaced to improve safety of transfer operations.
