Project Description/Justification:

The airport was recently reconstructed including installation of a new lighting system. The King Cove area borders on Izembek National Wildlife Refuge and experiences frequent visitation by brown bears. The new vertical elements of the lighting system are being subjected to intense ursine scrutiny as possible additions to their culinary menu. Resultant equipment damage is becoming excessive and a fencing project is needed to protect the Federal Aviation Administration funded investments and reduce maintenance costs.
