Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

State match required to pursue about \$165 million in federal Aviation Improvement Program funds and provide 1/2 of the match required for about \$40 million in federal funds for local sponsors' airports. The match will be used for rural and state primary airports (not Anchorage or Fairbanks). The non-federal match share is 5%. The State will provide 50% of the match required for projects at airports sponsored by local governments. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by improving the mobility of people and goods, reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage, and by increasing private investment.

Project Description/Justification:

The department provides the required match funding based on the estimated federal funding that will be available during the given fiscal year. The estimated amount needed to fund the FFY 2009 Federal Aviation Improvement Program is based on the amount of federal funds expected to be appropriated by Congress for FFY 2009.

Match funding is used for projects that have been previously authorized by the legislature and for projects that are in the FY 2009 capital budget. The state will continue to provide 50% of the match required for local sponsor airport projects.

The requested match amount is calculated as follows:

Rural Airport Program -

\$165.2 Million in federal funds requires a 5% state match (includes an estimated \$20.0M in discretionary funds) \$165.2 / 95% = \$173.9M (program total including match amount) \$173.9M - \$165.2M = \$8.7M match requirement

Local Sponsor Airport Program - the state provides half the required match

\$40.0 Million in federal funds requires a 5% match

\$40.0 / 95% = \$42.1M (program total including match)

\$42.1M - \$40.0M = \$2.1M match required

\$2.1M * 50% = \$1.1M is the State's share of the required match
