Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide the overall airport management and leadership necessary to assure that all airport functions are conducted in accordance with appropriate laws, regulations, policies, and procedures and in a safe, efficient, and cost-effective manner.

Core Services

- Plan, organize, direct and control airport functions.
- Develop and implement strategic management plans.
- Develop operating and capital budgets.
- Negotiate and administer 201 leases and other agreements.
- Administer airline operating agreements.
- Collect air carrier fees, rents, concession and other revenues.
- Collect and disseminate airport statistical and financial data.
- Maintain local area computer network backbone and workstations, and provide technical support to subsystems such as maintenance management, MSDS, HVAC.

Key Component Challenges

- Construction continues on replacement of the existing terminal building. The new section is slated to open in spring 2008. The airport will continue to operate the existing terminal until demolition of the oldest portion of the existing building begins.
- Dealing with geo-political developments in world wide cargo transport that directly affect revenues. Global air transport will continue to change as economic and political conditions change in rapidly developing countries such as China and Russia, as well as in central Asia. The impacts to the airport will be enormous as airlines make these important business decisions.
- One of FAI's greatest challenges is generating more revenue opportunities and maintaining existing revenues to support airport functions. In an effort to attract other air carriers or businesses to the airport to replace lost revenues, FAI staff will concentrate on marketing and outreach efforts with the aid of a USDOT Small Community Air Service Development Program grant. When it makes sense to do so, projects will be outsourced to private consultants
- Efforts continue to develop and implement competitive offerings for new telecommunications, rental car, and parking
 concessions: New telecommunications and rental car agreements to coincide with the opening of the new terminal
 scheduled for 2008; new parking agreement to coincide with completion of terminal construction project in 2009.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2009

No significant changes are anticipated.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2007

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- Award of new food and beverage and new gift and news concession agreements to be effective concurrently with anticipated public opening of the new terminal.
- Approved two new land leases with approximately \$250,000 in proposed improvements.
- In addition to proposed improvements on new leases, approved building permits for \$1.4 million in private investments on existing leaseholds on Airport land.
- Approved two new terminal leases with approximately \$10,000 in proposed improvements.
- Competed for and was awarded a three year USDOT Small Community Air Service Development Program grant for \$500.0.
