**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act making supplemental appropriations, capital appropriations,  
2 reappropriations, and other appropriations; amending certain appropriations;  
3 ratifying certain expenditures; making appropriations to capitalize funds; and  
4 providing for an effective date."

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 (SECTION 1 OF THIS ACT BEGINS ON PAGE 2)

1 \* Sec. 1. (a) If a collective bargaining agreement listed in (b) of this section is not ratified by the  
 2 membership of the respective collective bargaining unit, the appropriations made in (b) of this section  
 3 that are applicable to that collective bargaining unit's agreement are reduced proportionately by the  
 4 amount for that collective bargaining agreement, and the corresponding funding source amounts are  
 5 reduced accordingly.

6 (b) The following appropriations are for operating expenses and for salary and benefit adjustments for  
 7 public officials, officers, and employees of the executive branch, as set out in section 2 of this Act to  
 8 implement the terms for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, of the collective bargaining agreement of  
 9 the General Government Unit.
