 This project will provide funding to the City of Barrow to continue government operations and maintenance. It will allow the City to continue to provide the following public services and facilities to Barrow residents: cemeteries; recreation facilities and activities; business licensing; alcohol registration services; taxicab regulation services; boat ramps; multi-use facilities and gathering places; Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) services; passport services; removal of abandoned vehicles; and municipal monitoring of laws and regulations pertaining to aboriginal Inupiat lands. This project will also foster and protect Inupiat cultural traditions.
