#### **Key Component Challenges**

Recruit, hire and retain a work force of trained probation officers and supervisors.

Allocate resources to the offices and areas in the most need, sometimes at the expense of other offices.

Establishing and identify offenders currently incarcerated that will need additional assistance from the probation officer upon release.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2010

No changes in results delivered.

#### Major Component Accomplishments in 2008

Developed a Standard Operating Procedure for the supervision of sex offenders in the community.

A weeklong training was held in Anchorage with trainers from outside the State of Alaska presenting information on motivational interviewing; the risk needs assessment and the Interstate Compact for the supervision of adult offenders.

Legal training was provided to the probation officers for the first time in approximately 10 years.

Continued to recruit and fill vacant positions, primarily in Anchorage and Palmer.

Expanded the use of Sex Offender polygraph testing to Juneau.

Victim Notification system enrolled 3,069 victims during calendar year 2007. This is an increase from calendar year 2006 which had 2,175 victims enrolled.
