Complete any remaining local government agreements for expanding Spring Creek Correctional Center (SCCC, Seward), and Yukon-Kuskokwim Correctional Center (YKCC, Bethel), and for constructing Goose Creek Correctional Center (GCCC, Matanuska-Susitna Borough, Pt. MacKenzie).

Complete project designs and award construction contracts for expanding for SCCC and YKCC expansions.

Implement design and construction of the new prison in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.

Develop staffing requirements, recruitment and expanded training programs for all expansion projects.

Begin transition planning for all expansion projects.

Develop long-range expansion program for all correctional institutions to assure proper bed capacity to meet local institutional requirements.

# Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2010

No changes in results delivered.

## Major Component Accomplishments in 2008

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough and Department of Corrections (DOC) developed the facility program and solicited design / build proposals to construct a 1,536-bed institution at Goose Creek, Pt. MacKenzie. Contract award was issued in late October, 2008.

Developed lease-purchase and associated agreements with the Matanuska-Susitna Borough for the new institution.

In conjunction with the DOC Capital Improvements Projects / Facilities Management Section, developed lease, joint ownership and associated agreements with the City of Seward to design and construct the 144-bed expansion at SCCC.

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In conjunction with the DOC Capital Improvements Projects / Facilities Management Section, developed potential lease-purchase agreement to design and construct the 68-bed expansion at Yukon-Kuskokwim Correctional Center.

Developed a long range expansion program which defines projected capacity increase requirements at jails and prisons throughout Alaska.

Developed staffing requirements for the Goose Creek Correctional Center and developed hiring and training scenarios with the DOC Training Academy.

Assisted the DOC Budget Section in developing estimated budget increments for all proposed expansion options.
