**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Congress has passed and President Obama has signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The purpose of the federal appropriation bill is: "Making supplemental appropriations for job preservation and creation, infrastructure investment, energy efficiency and science, assistance to the unemployed, and State and local fiscal stabilization, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, and for other purposes." This capital project ensures that the State of Alaska can receive and expend any economic stimulus funding from the ARRA that departments become eligible for through competitive, discretionary or incentive grants.

**Project Description/Justification:**

Agencies of the Executive Branch do not yet have comprehensive information about the competitive, discretionary, or incentive grants for which they may be eligible to apply.
