### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Protects needy elderly, disabled and low-income Alaskan families from losing public assistance and medical benefits due to receipt of a permanent fund dividend. This protection was established in law in 1982.

### **Core Services**

Permanent Fund Dividend Hold Harmless payments replace Alaska Temporary Assistance, Adult Public
Assistance, Supplemental Security Income, and Food Stamp benefits for individuals who would lose eligibility or
whose benefits would be reduced if they received a Permanent Fund Dividend.
