Contribution to Department's Mission

The Department's mission is to promote and protect the health and well being of Alaskans. The Health Facilities Survey Program contributes to this by protecting the health and safety of Alaska's most vulnerable citizens and reducing their risk of exploitation. The program also ensures public confidence in the health care and community service delivery systems through regulatory, enforcement and educational activities.

Core Services

 Certification and licensing surveyors inspect health care facilities in the state to determine whether they meet state and federal standards, and investigate complaints made against care providers. The purpose of inspections is to determine a care provider's ability to offer services which are safe and of an acceptable quality.

Key Component Challenges

- Medicare funding is insufficient to cover expected unit costs related to mandated CMS expectations with rate increases of only 1% to 3% annually.
- With new regulations for the health facilities survey program, there are additional facilities for the section to monitor. This, in conjunction with more complaints per year, severely impacts staff workload. Growth in provider numbers continues to outpace an adequate number of staff positions.
- Recruitment and retention will continue to be a challenge as workload continues to increase. Because of the
 length of time it takes for surveyor training and orientation of new surveyors, reduction of the workload will be
 slow for the Health Facilities Survey Program. Training of new surveyors generally takes one to one-and-ahalf years due to federal mandated training for each provider type.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2010

The Health Facility Survey program, housed in the Certification and Licensing component in FY2009, will join the Health Care Services RDU in FY2010.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2008

- After several years of staffing recruitment and retention crisis, a class study was completed August 2008, which resulted in increased salaries.
- The program collaborated with other state agencies within the Centers of Medicaid/Medicare Services
 Region for assistance in completing critical inspections which would otherwise not get done without
 assistance.
- Partnership with the state's long term care providers continues to enhance communication between state and federal officials.
- Surveyors met federal mandated surveys and complaint investigations under critical staffing levels.
