Component: Alaska Vocational Technical Center

Contribution to Department's Mission

The Alaska Vocational Technical Center contributes to the department's mission by providing market-driven vocational and technical training to prepare state residents for jobs that are Alaska's future.

Core Services

- Train a diverse and effective workforce that supports the economic growth and stability of Alaska through postsecondary vocational and technical training.
- Offer long-term (longer than six weeks) vocational technical programs in occupations relating to Alaska's expanding and unique economy.
- Provide short-term training and education programs, which can be customized industry-specific training, to hundreds of Alaskans in many communities.
- Equip students with basic skills and workplace competencies to meet employer needs.
- Assist AVTEC graduates in obtaining employment or pursuing higher education within one year of graduating from a long-term AVTEC program.

Key Component Challenges

The most significant challenge AVTEC faces is to have the capacity to meet the existing demand for in-state training needs of Alaska's employers and the capability to expand to meet the anticipated needs of industry to support the Alaska Gas Pipeline.

The AVTEC Heavy Equipment/Diesel Technology program produces 30 trained Alaskans per year that are highly sought after by the mining, construction, oil/gas, and transportation industries for employment. With a nearly 100% job placement, this program is a stellar performer preparing Alaska residents for good wage jobs with opportunity for advancement. An FY 10 request for \$12,000.0 in capital funds will allow AVTEC to build a 16,000 SF steel fabricated building on AVTEC's Applied Tech campus to house the Heavy Equipment and Diesel programs. The Heavy Equipment program relocation will facilitate the demolition of the existing building which has ADA, code and life-and-safety deficiencies. The Diesel program relocation will allow the Pipe Welding program to be relocated to the existing Diesel Shop. This will provide the required adequate space for long pipe staging, storage and cutting. Providing adequate and safe environments for Heavy Equipment, Diesel, and Pipe Welding training is necessary to prepare state residents for jobs that are in high demand in Alaska.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2010

No change in results is anticipated.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2008

AVTEC trained 1,157 students in FY08, with AVTEC's graduation rate at 83%. The national graduation average is

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71%. Of those graduating, 93% were hired into training related employment. The national employment in the area of training average is 83%.

AVTEC increased its welding training capacity by adding a new Pipe Welding Shop and launching a new combination welder program. AVTEC can now train an additional 16 pipe welders a year.
