# Department of Labor and Workforce Development Fishermens Fund Component Budget Summary

#### **Component: Fishermens Fund**

#### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

The Fishermen's Fund component contributes to the department's mission by providing assistance with the medical and health care costs of occupational injuries or illnesses due to commercial fishing activities on shore or in state waters, allowing commercial fishermen to get back to work promptly.

#### **Core Services**

- Assist commercial fishers who are injured while commercial fishing by direct payment of medical benefits to health providers.
- Provide support to claims administrators, health providers, vessel owners, and injured workers by administering files, collecting data, maintaining case files, and reproducing information.
- Facilitate the adjudication of disputes between parties through administration of Alaska Fishermen's Fund Advisory and Appeals Council meetings.

#### **Key Component Challenges**

Promote awareness of the program and its benefits. Fishermen continue to require efforts to spread awareness of this program, its requirements and the availability of benefits for which they may be eligible. Medical and health care providers continue to require additional efforts to inform them of guidelines for submission and completion of claims. To address these issues the unit will need to investigate web-based training and communication programs for fishermen and/or health care providers.

The number of commercial fishing licenses and permits continues to decline each year. There were 69,500 licenses and permits issued in 1990, compared to 36,780 licenses and permits issued in 2008. Since the Fund's revenue is based on a percentage of each license and permit issued, the Fund has experienced a steady decrease in revenue over the same period of time.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2010

No significant changes in results are anticipated.

#### Major Component Accomplishments in 2008

In FY 08, the Fishermen's Fund received 766 claims and paid out \$823,235 in benefits.

Held regularly scheduled semi-annual meetings for the Council, one in the Fall and the other in the Spring to approve high cost claims.
