## **Project Description/Justification:**

Purchase property and construct a warehouse for shoreside storage of ferry spare parts and supplies in Homer. With the discontinuing of Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) operations in Seward, another warehouse facility is required. AMHS western operations have been storing their supplies and spare parts in vans for the last few years. Vans are notoriously "non-weather proof" and unheated. Vans are a poor way to store things.
