Project Description/Justification:

The existing snow removal equipment building is over 50 years old and beyond its useful life. It is too small to accommodate the new equipment needed at Unalakleet Airport, a regional hub airport with almost 10,000 enplanements. The current gravel runway is being paved, facilitating the need for new equipment such as a sand truck and towed broom. The snow removal equipment building needs to be large enough to house six pieces of equipment.

This request reflects a revised engineer's estimate.
