Project Description/Justification:

The existing runway is now rutted, coarse and soft in some areas. Dust from the airport is considered a major health and safety concern by the community. Northern Region Maintenance and Operations has difficulty dealing with the vegetation overgrowth on the operational surfaces and drainage problems are evident during break-up and wet weather.
