**Project Description/Justification:**

Projects for the Denali Commission are nominated by both department staff as well as local communities. This has created a need for department personnel to visit project locations during the nomination process. Since the Denali Commission's federal funds are not available for preliminary site visits, state funds are needed to facilitate the up-front discovery effort.
