Project Description/Justification:

Traffic has continued to increase on Geist Road since the completion of the Johansen Expressway. Geist Road connects the Parks Highway to the Johansen Expressway. The road surface has exceeded its service life and requires continuous maintenance. The pavement is cracked, rutted and over 20 years old. The pavement management system has rated this road as "poor". This project will increase traffic safety as well as pedestrian safety. The Geist/University intersection is the #1 accident intersection in Fairbanks.

Construction would be bid in the summer of 2009.
