Construction of 51 new miles of "island collector" road across Kupreanof Island between Kake and Petersburg with shuttle ferry terminals on either side of Wrangell Narrows near Petersburg. Project Description/Justification:

The state has an opportunity to partner with a power company to develop the corridor for an electrical intertie which will provide a combined project savings of \$25.1 million dollars. Partnering will reduce environmental impacts and road development will improve the utility's ability to inspect and repair electrical lines.

This project will connect Kake to much lower cost electrical power and regional transportation passenger and freight terminals in Petersburg. It will provide Kake residents access to medical and a wide variety of commercial services available in Petersburg. The Community of Kake is in desperate need of these improvements to provide economic relief.
