**Project Description/Justification:**

The majority of the shops catering to tourists are located across the main artery (AK Route 7) from the cruise ship berths. With up to 12,000 passengers per day disembarking, the crosswalks are heavily used. Most crosswalks, but not all of them, are ADA compliant. The crosswalks are currently marked with white striping paint on the asphalt pavement which is badly rutted, creating an uneven walking surface. The paint also wears off quickly during the summer season. This project will provide for a better walking surface and year-round delineation of the crosswalks.
