Project Description/Justification:

The current snow removal equipment building (1,104 square feet) in Alakanuk is located at the old airport which is several miles from the new airport. The building is more than 18 years old and has outlived its useful life. It is also in poor shape and does not meet the demands of the new airport. The existing building is too small and has experienced interior damage. The doors do not seal properly due to foundation settling and there is mold on the interior walls from the dirt floor and lack of adequate ventilation.
