This project will widen the New Seward Highway from four to six lanes from Tudor to Dowling Roads, and provide improvements for both frontage roads (Homer and Brayton Drives) to include multi-use trails, replace 5 bridges and construct an interchange at International Airport Road. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.
