## **Project Description/Justification:**

This project will construct an asphalt surface treatment on the existing gravel road, providing a smoother, more durable, and more easily maintained driving surface. Guardrail will be repaired to restore it to current standards, and signs will be replaced. This portion of the Steese Highway was constructed in the 1970's and early 1980's, and it has become difficult to maintain. Asphalt surface treatment will improve driving ability and safety and substantially lower the department's maintenance costs.
