**Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**

FY2009 - \$400,000; FY2008 - \$200,000; FY2007 - \$600,000; FY2006 - \$100,000; FY2004 - \$200,000; FY2003 - \$200,000; FY2001 - \$5,977,000; FY2000 - \$8,028,100; FY1999 - \$935,000. This is an annual program to coordinate with the Corps of Engineers and to match planning assistance funds.

**Project Description/Justification:**

This request would fund on-going coordination with the Corps of Engineers and local governments on Corps of Engineer projects and specific harbor related work not supported by other federal aid programs. Harbor activities to be funded include project evaluations, planning studies, surveys and inspections, statewide harbors directory update, special studies, and special reports. This funding is essential for the department to assure that viable projects and programs are advanced and poor projects and programs either become viable, are deferred or deleted from further consideration.

In addition, management of the Municipal Harbor Facility Grant (AS 29.60.800) program requires evaluation of applicants, grant agreement writing, legal reviews, inspections, and oversight of grant awardees. The department has a total of eleven grants to manage, two from 2007 and nine more in 2008.

This request also includes funds to make corrections to the state tideland surveys at state-owned harbor facilities. Completing this task will make it easier to transfer additional state-owned harbor facilities to local communities.
