#### **RDU/Component: Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing**

#### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Ensure that competent, professional and regulated commercial services are available to Alaska consumers.

#### **Core Services**

- Administer 40 licensing programs; 20 of these are supported solely by the division, and 20 are through support to boards and commissions
- License businesses to engage in commerce in Alaska, and grant tobacco endorsements for sale of tobacco or tobacco-related products
- Provide the means to file a complaint or bring a matter pertaining to actions of a licensed or unlicensed professional or business to investigative staff
- Provide consumer outreach and education regarding services of state licensed professionals
- Register Corporations and Trademarks for entities engaged in commerce in Alaska

## END RESULT A: Commercial services are licensed and professional services have competent, qualified licensees.

• .63% decline in the number of commercial and professional services licenses from 114,307 in FY09 to 113,588 in FY10; reducing the choice consumers have in selecting a licensed provider.

#### Status of Strategies to Achieve End Result

• In FY10, 22% of licensing programs have online capabilities.

#### END RESULT B: Business, professional and commercial services are compliant with licensing regulations.

• There were 701 complaints received in FY10 resulting in 556 new cases opened and 333 cases closed with some sort of disciplinary response by the division. All complaints received by the division for FY10 were reviewed.

#### Status of Strategies to Achieve End Result

• In FY10, of the 556 investigation cases opened, 397 (71%) resulted in disciplinary actions.

#### **Key Component Challenges**

The division continues the process of overhauling and enhancing many of its automated systems and processes for efficiency and improved services for consumers. Although great strides have been made in systems and processes,

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work needs to continue. Some systems are still antiquated or cumbersome and less 'user friendly' than desired for the public and staff.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

No significant changes to component. The division requests continued funding to implement the federally mandated Alaska Prescription Drug Monitoring program.

#### Major Component Accomplishments in 2010

**Automated Systems -** Significant improvements to automated systems came online or are very near completion. These systems include: a new application for Corporation filings; a new Investigative case management tracking system; and online renewal capabilities for programs not currently available. Benefits of these improvements include ease of use by licensees in the application or renewal process and information handling by staff.

**Continuation of Licensing Boards Under Sunset Review -** Three licensing Boards under sunset review were extended by the Legislature, some with amendments to the licensing statutes. These programs consisted of: 1) Board of Real Estate Appraisers; 2) Board of Marital and Family Counseling; and 3) Board of Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners.

**Special Investigator for Guides-Transporters -** The division placed an Investigator III into the field in response to a one-time appropriation for observation, interviews and investigations into Game Guide and Transporter activities. Focus of this activity was compliance with Big Game Commercial Services Board statute and regulations.

**Corporations -** Significant improvements were made to processing systems for Corporation registrations, filings, and renewals. Improvements resulted in reductions in response time from 14 weeks to two weeks or less in the handling of applications and other required corporate transactions.
