Contribution to Department's Mission

Assure viable utility and pipeline service is provided with just and reasonable rates to consumers in Alaska.

Core Services

- Thoroughly review utility and pipeline filings for compliance and approval (examples: certificate applications, rate cases, PCE rates, telecom and natural gas competition, tariffs, ETC applications, interconnection agreements)
- Clear guidance to utility and pipeline service providers.
- Ensure Alaska's interests are considered in the development of federal legislation and regulations (examples: participation in national forums, FCC proceedings, FERC proceedings)
- Dispute resolution involving regulated entities (examples: telecom disputes, consumer disputes, pipeline disputes)
- Public information and education to enhance the public's understanding and use of utility and pipeline services (examples: website, press releases, outreach workshops)

END RESULT A: Alaskan consumers receive fair treatment, and just and reasonable rates from utilities and pipelines.

- 99.95% of the tariff filings made in FY10 were reviewed and processed within regulatory timelines.
- 91.9% of PCE eligible utilities were in compliance at the end of FY10.
- In FY10, 100% of the Regulatory Commission final orders in adjudicatory dockets were reviewed by an assistant attorney general and 100% of the final decisions were issued on or before the statutory deadline.

Status of Strategies to Achieve End Result

- In FY10, 80% of the written dispositions for complaints received by mail were completed within 45 days.
- In FY10, 85.6% of the dispositions were completed within 30 days for complaints received by telephone, fax, email, or walk-in.
- 80.7% of the fuel prices changes filed were reviewed and responsive letter orders issued within 21 days in FY10.
- 43.5% of filed PCE Utility Annual Reports were reviewed in FY10, an increase of 29% over FY09.
- At the end of FY10, 85% of the professional/technical advisory staff positions were filled within the Regulatory Commission of Alaska, not meeting the target of 100%.
- In FY10 the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA) extended one statutory timeline (2.77%) on its own motion.
- The Regulatory Commission of Alaska participated in ten outreach opportunities in FY10.
- The Consumer Protection and Information Section of the Regulatory Commission of Alaska developed three new consumer fact sheets and revised 10 existing consumer fact sheets in FY10.
- The RCA did not conduct training sessions on web filing or application and general filing requirements during FY10.

Key Component Challenges

Continue to attract and retain qualified professional staff, administrative law judges and Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA) Commissioners. Industry representatives urge the resolution of matters and the issuance of a greater percentage of decisions in advance of statutory timelines. The commission focuses resources on addressing matters with most urgent statutory timelines. To respond with earlier decisions the RCA needs fewer staff vacancies and possibly additional highly qualified personnel and resources.

Develop and implement regulations to guide the use of electronic filing and electronic distribution of commission information.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

No significant changes to component. RCA requests continuation of the FY12 portion of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant funding to assist state regulatory commissions to perform their regulatory responsibilities with regard to ARRA electricity-related activities and investments.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2010

Reduced potential for widespread winter power shortages by approving five natural gas supply contracts between utility service providers and natural gas suppliers

Extended the time that a single area code, 907, is used statewide in Alaska. With cooperation of the telecommunications industry, adopted strategies and addressed implementation issues for optimizing the use of 907 numbering resources.

Adopted net metering regulations which facilitate small scale renewable generation by electric customers. These regulations make it easier for certain electric consumers to reduce their load requirement by interconnecting on-site generation facilities to electric utility facilities. The amount of customer-generated power will be compared to the customer's electric consumption for the applicable billing period, with the customer either billed for net electric consumption or credited for generating more electricity than used in a billing period.

Assured facility enhancement and delivery of reliable electric service in a remote Alaska community that had endured long-term poor service. The commission authorized a different provider that was already operating electric utilities in other rural Alaska communities.
