Component Budget Summary

Component: Unemployment Insurance

Contribution to Department's Mission

The Unemployment Insurance program contributes to the department's mission by keeping skilled workers in Alaska and sustaining the economy during periods of economic downturn.

Core Services

- Pay Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits to eligible workers who are temporarily unemployed.
- Assess and collect employer contributions for deposit into the UI Trust Fund.
- Provide web-based products to workers and employers for accessing the Tax On-Line System and Benefit Internet Filing system.
- Work with and educate employers on how to meet the UI tax and reporting requirements.
- Ensure trust fund solvency is maintained by reviewing UI tax rate calculations.
- Protect integrity of the UI Trust Fund by detecting, preventing and recovering UI benefit overpayments.
- Provide Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund accounting.

Key Component Challenges

There is an increased reliance on information technology and the program will continue to concentrate on delivering core Unemployment Insurance (UI) products electronically to ensure employers and claimants receive adequate and continuous services. However, progress on current projects to improve services through the use of information technology will continue to be a challenge due to the limited availability of programming staff and varying levels of centralized IT support services.

The program is constantly challenged to meet federal performance and quality measures (adjudication and timeliness), as well as overall customer service as multiple UI extension programs and related workload continue to strain available resources. As the workload increases due to the number of claims filed and issues adjudicated, it remains difficult to meet federal timeliness requirements in the Appeals Unit. A lack of trained hearing officers, due to staff turnover and the length of time to train, has negatively affected timeliness for 30 and 90 day appeals.

Staff are challenged to keep up with the workload generated from paying multiple extension programs and multiple tiers of the federal Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC) program. On July 22, 2010, Congress enacted the Unemployment Compensation Extension Act of 2010, extending EUC eligibility and the phase our period through April 30, 2011. As of October 2010, Alaska's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate is 7.8 percent. As a result, the High Unemployment Period (8 percent or above) expired and state Extended Benefits (EB) remain available for 13 weeks instead of 20. Eligible claimants that have exhausted their regular UI and EB benefits may be eligible to file for and collect benefits under the EUC program. There are currently three tiers of EUC that can pay 47 additional weeks.

The ongoing UI Data Validation (UIDV) project to revise programs that confirm the validity of data used to generate federal Employment and Training Administration UI reports continues to undergo delays. Federally mandated changes to the operation of the UIDV program have resulted in the issuance of several software releases, data extracts, data transmission procedures and structure of the database that stores the UIDV summary results. While Alaska was successful in submitting all populations timely for federally mandated Benefit Data Validations, not all passed. Remediation on all populations is expected to continue through 2011. Populations that did not pass will be revalidated and submitted for validation year 2011(April 1, 2010 through March 30, 2011).

Federal or State law changes often require that on-going projects are delayed while work is performed to carry out the new directives. System and processing changes resulting from the spring 2010 federal audit of the EB, EUC, and FAC programs have placed additional workload on analysts and data processing staff. The federal government has directed several actions that will require significant changes to the current benefit payment system. Consequently, data processing and programming resources will be moved off current projects to program and test for these changes.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

The Unemployment Insurance (UI) Claims Centers provide services to unemployed Alaskan workers. There has been continued increases in UI benefit requests since July 2008 and this trend will continue through FY2012. These additional requests for benefits have escalated the need for improving claims center technology in a timely and cost effective manner. As a result, the Division has procured a statewide Virtual Call Center system. This new system will give the program the capability to audit the use of and better secure confidential information. During the coming year, that system will be delivered in several phases. The first phase will result in the ability to route calls based on data and load availability across all three claims centers statewide. This phase will also include virtual queuing systems that will allow customers to receive callbacks instead of waiting in the queue. The second phase will include audio recording, screen population display, agent profile/skills-based routing, data driven routing, and Integrated Voice Recognition. The third and final phase is scheduled for May 2011 and will include integrated strategy management/monitoring, last agent/relationship based routing, service level routing and email integration. The new system will better serve UI claimants and provide a level of service currently not being experienced.

Quality Control (QC) will begin providing comprehensive reports to UI managers outlining specific reasons for overpayments and underpayments identified during audits. This will be a useful tool in identifying potential training issues for UI staff and should result in fewer improper payments over time.

Marketing efforts will be made to increase the number of Alaska employers using the internet to file their reports and make payments. These efforts include mailing out instructions to those not already using the online system, placing posters in prominent areas at service points of delivery, adding a flyer to both UI Tax and "New Employer" packets, and personal contacts to payroll service providers. UI Tax staff will continue to work with larger employers (those with 100 or more employees, and/or a million dollars of taxable wages or more), to comply with regulations and file their reports online.

UI Tax will acquire a Tax Auditors software tool to be used by field auditors when conducting on-site audits of employer records. The application will lighten the workload of staff by requiring much less manual intervention, fewer review and approval processes, and provide improved documentation. In addition, federal reporting measures will be improved by ensuring compliance with mandated Tax Performance Systems standards.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2010

Unemployment Insurance benefits totaling \$331.4 million were paid to 67,632 insured workers. This is an increase of \$137 million in benefits and 12,889 insured workers from last year. During the same period \$135.8 million in contributions were deposited into the Trust Fund. This represents \$6.1 million less than was collected last year and is due to an average lower tax rate on employers.

The component completed upgrades to the Benefits Internet Filing (BIF) system to allow individuals to file for benefit extensions and enroll in direct deposit and debit cards. During the past year, 37 percent of initial claims and 29 percent of weekly certifications were filed through the BIF system. Online filing is an efficient, cost effective alternative and the program continues to look for ways to enhance and promote the BIF system.

Tax Online Services continue to improve staff efficiency and simplify quarterly contribution filing for Alaska employers. A total of 29,876 reports were filed online in FY2010. To date, 43 percent of all active Alaska employers are filing their reports online. Over \$32 million was collected through electronic fund transfers in FY2010.

Benefit Payment Control increased collection activities resulting in the recovery of approximately \$1.8 million in fraudulent benefit overpayments and \$3.1 million in other overpaid benefits. Of this total, over \$1.06 million was recovered through Permanent Fund Dividend (PFD) levy requests submitted to the Department of Revenue.

The component continues to improve electronic payment of benefits through direct deposit and debit cards. Currently, 87.5 percent of UI recipients are receiving benefits electronically. This represents a 15 percent increase from FY2009. Electronic payment offers secure and timely payment to unemployed Alaskans, while providing a cost savings to the state. The average cost per check is \$1.80 including postage. The program processed 601,989

electronic disbursements last year at a cost of \$.03 per transaction. Had the division issued checks instead of electronic payments, the cost would have been in excess of \$1million.

The Division implemented an Alternate Base Period (ABP) January 1, 2010, to meet federal requirements of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 for receiving the federal Unemployment Compensation Modernization special transfer stimulus funding. The ABP allows workers who do not meet the minimum earnings threshold using the standard base period to recalculate their eligibility based on the last four completed calendar quarters. To date, this represents a decrease of 15.6 percent of monetarily ineligible claims. By implementing this change in law, Alaska received a one-time \$5.2 million award under ARRA. To qualify and receive the remaining \$10.4 million provided under ARRA, the Division amended the Alaska Administrative Code to allow a claimant's separation from employment due to compelling family and medical reasons.

Despite staffing shortages, claims centers answered 263,369 calls. During the same period, 51,176 Extended Benefit and Emergency Unemployment Compensation claims were filed. Even with the additional workload, Alaska was able to exceed the federal performance levels for non-monetary determination quality, first pay timeliness and adjudication timeliness.

Although the component was able to secure 26 long-term non-permanent positions, last year's federal workload allocations justified funding for an additional 22.5 positions to process and administer UI benefits. Administrative cost data under the Resource Justification Model (RJM) allocates funding based on workload function for claims and employer activity. In spite of not having these positions, the division was able to process claims and make benefit payments timely.

As a result of improvements the component made in the auditing process and access to online tools, the Quality Control Unit met federal timeliness goals with 96 percent of the cases being completed in 60 days or less. The Unit converted all paper audits into an electronic format, making it completely paperless. Further enhancements to online interactive forms are under review to streamline the interviewing of claimants and documentation of the interviews.

The Unemployment Insurance (UI) component is requesting an increment establishing new FY11 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) authorization in the amount of \$600.0 for improvement of UI benefit and tax operations and to respond to an increased demand for UI benefits. These are additional ARRA funds that are earned as a result of reimbursement for ARRA related UI claims processed. The claims workload has increased to the point that the current ARRA authorization level is not sufficient to accept all of the federal reimbursement available.

An increment request of \$351.1 for new ARRA funding was included in the original Governor's budget; however this amount has now proven to be too low. The program has already received federal notification of \$601.1 in new ARRA funds and anticipates receiving additional amounts on a quarterly basis. It is very difficult to forecast future claims activity which may result in this increased authorization also being insufficient; however, this is the best estimate we can currently justify.

Funds will be used along with regular UI federal base grant funding for information technology training and contracts, including ongoing enhancements to the UI Tax and Benefit programs and to support program staff costs such as telephone, postage, computer mainframe usage costs, software licensing and maintenance.
