#### **Component: Data Processing**

#### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

The Data Processing component contributes to the department's mission by providing technical, analytical and business specific expertise to assist our customers in efficiently achieving their goals.

#### **Core Services**

- Developing, integrating and maintaining agency specific applications.
- Securing data contained in agency databases and files.
- Supporting and enhancing agency information infrastructure.

#### **Key Component Challenges**

A lack of Data Network bandwidth to rural Alaska creates significant barriers to providing services to customers in those areas. Very basic services such as being able to test for an Airport Security job currently requires that customers travel to Anchorage, Juneau, or Fairbanks, or get permission from an organization in their community with good bandwidth to allow use of their computers.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

Deliver a new Workers' Compensation System that allows the business unit to better interface with other state and federal agencies in exchanging information and reducing costs.

Deliver a new Workforce Investment Act System that allows tracking of grants and outcomes to better target the training monies available.

Begin deployment of thin clients, which are a less expensive alternative to personal computers and require less frequent updates, to yield long-term support savings to the department.

#### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2010**

Modified, tested, and implemented a multitude of changes to the Unemployment Insurance systems. This allowed unemployed workers to collect more benefits over a longer period to stimulate the economy and help them through the recession.

Implemented the Workers Compensation Electronic Data Interchange system. This will allow data to be efficiently gathered and processed by Workers Compensation Claimants and by insurance providers.

Developed and implemented the Reemployment Services Module for the ALEXsys job exchange system. This allows for re-employment self-service orientation, claimant self-scheduling of orientation and workshops, workshop setup, and improvements in linkages between the Unemployment Insurance system and Job Exchange system.

Worked through a multitude of problems and issues related to the upgrade of the mainframe operating system, transaction processing upgrade, compiler upgrade, and database upgrade. It was another extraordinarily busy year for upgrading the mainframe.
