Department of Law Administrative Services Component Budget Summary

### **Component: Administrative Services**

### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Administrative Services provides budgeting, accounting, procurement, and computing services to the Department of Law. These services enable and enhance the Department in its mission to provide legal services to state agencies and prosecute crime.

#### **Core Services**

- Financial management and forecasting
- Budgeting
- Fiscal and Accounting
- Procurement and mail services
- Information Services
- Timekeeping and Billing
- Cost Allocation

### **Key Component Challenges**

Address the decline in federal funding while operating costs continue to increase.

Increase the quality of service by taking advantage of new technologies.

Existing electronic systems system cannot receive collection information electronically from the court system, where obligations for the public to pay fines, cost of incarceration and cost of appointed counsel originate. The existing infrastructure within Administrative Services is antiquated and has exceeded its capacity. Currently information must be manually entered into the individual databases and into the accounting system. The Division must continue to improve this process to ensure it is timely and accurate.

### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

The Division is replacing our existing Criminal case management system, running on obsolete eight year old hardware and technology, with a new version of the system. This upgrade will also set the stage for the Criminal Division to begin enhancing the transfer of information between the Department of Law, the Alaska Court System and law enforcement agencies in FY 2012.

The Division will use products associated with the new timekeeping system to develop and produce monthly reports for management review.

### Major Component Accomplishments in 2010

The procurement unit continued to secure and provide administrative support for contracts with various outside legal counsel and experts to advise and assist with ongoing gas line negotiations and in other major royalty and tax disputes with the oil and gas industry as well as contracts for the support and enhancement of critical information and management systems.

The procurement unit secured the services of several nationally recognized legal practitioners to represent the State before the United States Supreme Court in the high profile *Osborne* case (in re: DNA evidence) and as an amicus in the taxation dispute: *Polar Tankers, Inc. v. City of Valdez.* 

The procurement unit completed necessary remodeling and installation of electronic controls needed to enhance the security of Civil Division offices on the 5th and 6th floors of the Dimond Courthouse.

The information technology section completed installation, configuration and operation of two Storage Area Networks (SAN's), one in Juneau and one in Anchorage. These systems have expanded the department's data capacity, disaster recovery, and data availability. This technology directly dovetails with the department's plans to increase the digitization of case information and document storage.

The information technology section has begun implementation of an upgraded version of the Criminal Case Management system employed by the department's Criminal Division.

The Administrative Services Director created, distributed, and received feedback on a customer satisfaction survey, specific to Department of Law employees. The division received feedback on specific functions, such as: travel, procurement, timekeeping, collections and restitution, budget services, and general administrative functions.

The employees were asked to give an overall grade of services provided by the division and they were: A-31.3%, B-40.6%, C-23.4%, D-3.1%, and F-1.6%.

From the data collected and the comments received, the director is reviewing current procedures and determining where streamlining and changes can be made without increasing costs or personnel.
