Department of Transportation/Public Facilities Anchorage Airport Field and Equipment Maintenance Component Budget Summary

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Component: Anchorage Airport Field and Equipment Maintenance

Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide safe aircraft movement surfaces through efficient and cost-effective maintenance of the Air Operations Area, and to maintain vehicle roads, parking lots and other grounds in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) airport certification requirements, as well as accepted prudent maintenance requirements and practices.

Core Services

- Provide physical maintenance of all runways, taxiways, aircraft parking, vehicle parking lots, roads, sidewalks, surface drainage, and grounds within the boundaries of the 4,500+ acre airport, as well as both sides of perimeter fencing.
- Purchase, maintain, and repair rolling stock, firefighting equipment, vehicles, and controlled property (small equipment).
- Repair/maintain and remove snow and ice from all pavement areas, airport runways, taxiways, roadways, sidewalks, and grounds.
- Perform daily maintenance inspections of airport areas and retain related data required by Federal Aviation Regulations (FAR) 139 regulations.
- Repair and maintain 322 lake slips, 458 wheeled tiedowns, and one dirt runway serving general aviation commercial and private aircraft owners.
- Provide installation and maintenance of all airport lighting on runways, taxiways, ramps, general aviation areas, parking lots, and roadways.
- Perform surface friction testing on all runways as required by FAA and retain those reports.
- Provide emergency support on all aircraft alert conditions as well as any other emergencies that may arise.

Key Component Challenges

- The costs associated with deicing chemicals will increase in FY2012 significantly since the vendor that supplied the deicing chemical urea has closed. The cost of urea was \$340 per ton delivered up until 2009 and the current cost of urea is \$719 per ton delivered. Previously stockpiled material is nearly gone and will not last through the 2010 winter.
- There are currently 20 vacancies in this component (18% of total positions). Some positions are being held open for cost containment; however, recruitment problems are still an issue. It is more difficult to recruit qualified equipment operators, mechanics, and electricians than ever before. Critical positions have remained unfilled for several months. Contacts were made with Local 71, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), Operators Union Local 302 and construction contractors with no prospective applicants found. The present pay rate has not kept up with the local economy. It takes two to three seasons for a new employee to become proficient with the specialized airport equipment and to be able to maneuver the equipment safely around the airport. Employees are not staying long enough to get past the training mode. The new FAA circular requires us to increase our personnel and equipment to meet these new requirements. This winter Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (ANC) will have to rely on working the crews with overtime to ensure the safety of the traveling public.
- The closing of Kulis Air National Guard Base is going to have an airport wide impact. The Base has begun the closure process, and will be complete by 2011. ANC has been working on the impacts and issues for over a year. Field & Equipment will acquire an additional 31 road miles to maintain in addition to all the grasslands and sidewalks, exterior roadway lighting, and the Kulis taxiway. New security fence and access road will be required in order to make the Kulis fire station accessible to the aircraft operation area.
- Consistent with other ANC components, safety is of the foremost importance for Field and Equipment Maintenance. To ensure that the airport is maintained to the highest level of safety and proficiency requires a highly trained and qualified staff.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

No significant changes are anticipated.

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Major Component Accomplishments in 2010

- Runways and taxiways remained open.
- Successfully completed the FAA 14 CFR Part 139 inspection.
- Kept the airport open with runway 7R out of service all summer.
- Emergency repairs of sinkholes on runway 32.Completed emergency repairs of aircraft movement areas.
- Removed trees airport wide to bring airport in compliance with Part 77 airspace requirements.
