Component: Anchorage Airport Safety

Contribution to Department's Mission

To protect people and their property with the best police and firefighting professionals. To perform airport rescue and firefighting, law enforcement, emergency medical technician, and airfield operation services that meet Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) airport certification and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) security requirements in a cost effective manner, while being responsive to the public, airport management, and community needs.

Core Services

- Provide crash/fire rescue and emergency medical services for Anchorage International Airport (ANC) in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) mandates as well as other federal, state, and local requirements.
- Plan, staff, train for, and respond to real and simulated aircraft and bomb threat incidents, accidents, and natural disasters.
- Provide or contract for law enforcement, traffic control, and guard service on ANC property.
- Coordinate all TSA required security measures and mandates such as inspection of security points on ANC property including gates and fencing.
- Provide oversight of passenger screening activities.

Key Component Challenges

- The need to ensure Transportation Security Administration (TSA) and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulatory compliance is met continues to be a challenge. The TSA and FAA regularly modify and change their standards, thereby increasing the challenges of meeting these responsibilities.
- Live fire training on a yearly basis, which is an FAA requirement under Part 139 continues to be problematic. The environmental impact of using the live fire pit is continually monitored. Obtaining a mobile trainer trailer will (1) cut down on the use of a live fire pit for two of three years and (2) provide a safer training environment as the trainer can control the propane fire. Installation of a "fixed" propane live fire training facility would ultimately resolve these issues.
- Kulis Fire Department is scheduled to be closed in 2011. The Kulis station can be used for quicker responses to meet FAA Part 139 and provide storage for police and fire fighting equipment. Finding a solution on how best to operationally incorporate this new facility will be a challenge.
- The Municipality of Anchorage (Anchorage Fire Department) recently withdrew their participation in a mutual aid agreement with ANC to provide water rescue services and equipment. Maintaining the infrastructure, equipment and services to comply with this FAA regulatory requirement is a challenge.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

No significant changes are anticipated.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2010

- Completion of a major renovation to the Police & Fire Building, including the addition of two new stalls in the truck bay.
- In cooperation and partnership with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, completion of a major upgrade to the Airport's firing range located on the south side of the Airport. Several investigations that led to indictments and convictions against defendants in several high profile criminal cases.
- A recruitment process that led to the hiring of six new employees in August 2010.
