Component Budget Summary

### **Component: Fairbanks Airport Administration**

#### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Provide the overall airport management and leadership necessary to assure that all airport functions are conducted in accordance with appropriate laws, regulations, policies, and procedures and in a safe, efficient, and cost-effective manner.

#### **Core Services**

- Plan, organize, direct and control airport functions.
- Develop and implement strategic management plans and airport operating and capital budgets.
- Promote Fairbanks International Airport (FAI) in domestic and international markets through personal outreach, consultant services, collateral material, and the FAI website.
- Negotiate and administer 190 active leases and other agreements.
- Administer airline operating agreements and update as negotiated.
- Collect air carrier fees, rents, concession and other revenues.
- Collect and disseminate airport statistical and financial data.
- Maintain local area computer/telephone network backbone and workstations and WIFI, and provide technical support to subsystems such as maintenance management, Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) environmental hazards database, security badging and automated Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) systems.

#### **Key Component Challenges**

- Global air transport opportunities will continue to change as economic and political conditions change in China, Asia Major, Russia, and central Asia. Marketing staff will concentrate on outreach efforts to attract air carriers to FAI and mitigate the negative effects of global route changes.
- Work in conjunction with Anchorage International Airport to resolve aviation fuel supply issues that are impacting both airports.
- Staff is continuing efforts to develop and implement competitive offerings for new automated teller machines (ATM) and parking lot concessions.
- Installation of Common Use Passenger Processing System (CUPPS) at ticketing points in the new terminal
  which will allow multiple air carriers to run their own proprietary ticketing and baggage software from shared
  common-use equipment.
- Improve the computer network backup and disaster recovery system to meet current Department of Administration (DOA), Enterprise Technology Services (ETS) standards, with which the network is not currently compliant.

### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2012

No significant changes are anticipated.

### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2010**

- Delta Airlines re-instated seasonal service at FAI direct to Salt Lake City and plans to continue this service in 2011. Condor Airlines experienced a 5% increase in European visitors to Fairbanks and an 18% increase outbound passengers via their direct scheduled service from Frankfurt, Germany compared to the Whitehorse leg of the route that saw a 14% decrease in traffic from last year.
- FAI provided 14 tours to local community groups and public schools in 2010.
- The Small Community Air Service Development Grant was utilized to bring low cost carrier Frontier Airlines
  into FAI with four times per week seasonal service to Denver, Colorado. FAI worked in conjunction with the
  Fairbanks Convention & Visitors Bureau to launch this service. Frontier will expand this service to five times
  per week in 2011.
- Executed new hangar lease on west side with total investment of \$2.5 million.

- Completed file maintenance and updates for all leases.
- Submitted Fair Market Value Appraisal of Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Base Building to Alaska International Airport System (AIAS) Controller for approval to sell to FAA.
- Approved Building Permit Applications for investments totaling \$598.0.
- Issued new Business Activity Permits for all fuel dispensers at FAI.
