Contribution to Department's Mission

Incarcerate and supervise male and female, sentenced and unsentenced adult felons and misdemeanants that are committed to the custody of the department.

Core Services

- Offender Confinement
- Behavioral Intervention

Key Component Challenges

Recruit, hire and retain a workforce of well-trained officers to meet the challenge of facility standards and public protection.

Reduce the ongoing deterioration of the facility and backlog.

Assure that current department standards for security, safety and current correctional practices are adhered to.

Meet operational expectations while striving to remain within the fiscal parameters.

Continue improvements in crop production, processing and storage capabilities to augment departmental food supplies. Increase storage space to warehouse potatoes and vegetables to allow for year-round distribution to other correctional facilities.

Provide for timely and efficient screening and assessment of all inmates to allow appropriate placement, programming and transition to community supervision.

Inmate population continues to drive exceptional transportation and medical costs in an attempt to assure appropriate prisoner care and institutional safety. The increases to inmate populations continue to create numerous logistical and financial challenges.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013

No changes in results delivered.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2011

Under the Alaska Railroad agreement, prisoners clear and process moose struck by trains. The Food Bank of Alaska was given approximately 4,000 lbs of fresh ground moose meat for distribution to families living below the poverty level.

Donated over 575 man hours to the Mat-Su Animal Shelter to provide care for rescued domestic animals.

Provided emergency care for 28 rescued huskies. PMCF provided these dogs shelter, domestic care and socialization. The goal was to make these dogs adoptable as household pets.

Donated more than 2,000 man hours to Toga Woods Girl Scout Camp for clean-up, wood cutting, setting-up and taking-down of tents and other camp items. Constructed picnic tables and fire rings for use at Girl Scout camps in the Anchorage Bowl area from materials provided by the Girl Scouts.

Harvested approximately 1,200,000 lbs of agricultural products. Produce was distributed to other DOC facilities to

offset their food costs. The remainder was donated to the Food Bank of Alaska for needy families.

Cared for and raised approximately 90 head cattle, 125 pigs/hogs, 2 goats and 650 egg producing chickens.

Provided annual neighborhood clean up along major roads in the Mat-Su Borough.

Point MacKenzie Correctional Farm continues to provide evidence-based programming in the areas of education, vocation, re-entry, parenting and criminal thinking.

Point MacKenzie Correctional Farm provided in-house training to staff in the areas of fire, life and safety and institutional protocols. Staff completed approximately 25 hours of training.
