Per the Department of Revenue (DOR), the fiscal year-to-date average price of Alaska North Slope crude as of August 1, 2011, was \$114.08 per barrel, which is \$19.38 (20.5%) above DOR's Spring 2011 FY2012 forecast amount of \$94.70.
