#### **Component: Yukon-Kuskokwim Correctional Center**

#### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Incarcerate and supervise male and female, sentenced and unsentenced adult felons and misdemeanants that are committed to the custody of the department.

Recruit, hire and retain a workforce of well-trained officers to meet the challenge of facility standards and public protection.

Reduce the ongoing deterioration of the facility and backlog.

Assure that current department standards for security, safety and current correctional practices are adhered to.

Meet operational expectations while striving to remain within the fiscal parameters.

Participate in the review, design, planning and coordination of facility expansion project with department management.

Provide for timely and efficient screening and assessment of all inmates to allow appropriate placement, programming and transition to community supervision.

Inmate population continues to drive exceptional transportation and medical costs in an attempt to assure appropriate prisoner care and institutional safety. The significant increase in the inmate populations continues to create numerous logistical, security and financial challenges.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013

No changes in results delivered.

#### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2011**

Yukon-Kuskokwim Correctional Center (YKCC) continues to successfully hire new staff with an ongoing effort to promote regional hires with applicants from the Bethel region.

The fishing season produced approximately 2,200 fish, which included Kings, Silvers, Reds and Chum Salmon weighing approximately 7-15 lbs each. Offenders washed, cleaned, gutted, packaged, and froze the fish to be incorporated into offender meals served at YKCC.

The YKCC continues to provide evidence-based programming in the areas of education, vocation, substance abuse treatment, re-entry, parenting and criminal thinking.

The YKCC provided in-house training to staff in the areas of fire, life and safety and institutional protocols. Staff completed approximately 40 hours of training.
