Major Component Accomplishments in 2011

Mat-Su Correctional Center continues to provide evidence-based programming in the areas of education, vocation, substance abuse treatment, re-entry, parenting and criminal thinking.

Mat-Su Correctional Center provided in-house training to staff in the areas of fire, life and safety and institutional protocols. Staff completed an average of 33.2 hours of training per staff member.

Extensive upgrade of the outside recreational area internal and external security perimeter.

Maintenance Projects:

- 6 cells repainted
- Metal window covers were fabricated for the booking cells to ensure privacy and increase security
- New security cameras installed in B holding cell and Booking area for additional security
- New cell vent covers installed in all cells to eliminate the possibility of hiding contraband and constructing weapons
- 4 cell ceilings were repaired/re-welded to eliminate the possibility of hiding contraband
- 2 circulation pumps were replaced

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- Installed new ice machine in the kitchen
- Installed new garbage disposal in the kitchen under the dishwasher
- Kitchen hood was cleaned and serviced as a preventive to kitchen grease fires
