Contribution to Department's Mission

Incarcerate and supervise male and female, sentenced and unsentenced adult felons and misdemeanants that are committed to the custody of the department.

Participate in review, design, planning and coordination of facility expansion project with department management.

Meet operational expectations while remaining within budget.

Provide for timely and efficient screening and assessment of all inmates to allow for appropriate placement, programming and transition to community supervision.

Inmate population continues to drive exceptional transportation and medical costs in an attempt to assure appropriate prisoner care and institutional safety. The increases to inmate populations continue to create numerous logistical and financial challenges.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013

No changes in results delivered.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2011

The 24 bed male Sex Offender Therapeutic Community Program began in 2009 and is proving beneficial to inmates enrolled. The Program has recently produced its first round of graduates.

Female inmates are given the opportunity to give back to the community via a sewing group that makes blankets and pillows. Materials to make the blankets and pillows are donated. Female inmates made and donated approximately 50 blankets to non-profit agencies throughout the community.

Lemon Creek Correctional Center held its annual "Success Inside and Out" Conference. In coordination with the Alaska Court System, this event draws local businesses such as Odom Corporation, Subway, McDonalds, Pepsi Corporation, Bullwinkles and Northland Services and aids inmates transitioning back into the community.

Lemon Creek Correctional Center continues to provide evidence-based programming in the areas of education, vocation, substance abuse treatment, re-entry, parenting and criminal thinking.

Lemon Creek Correctional Center provided in-house training to staff in the areas of fire, life and safety and institutional protocols. Staff completed approximately 38 hours of training.
