Secure Confinement

The department maintained zero prisoner escapes from an institutional facility during FY2011 as identified under AS 11.56.300.

The number of special incident reports decreased from 70 during calendar year 2009 to 66 during calendar year 2010.

Supervised Release

During FY2011, 1,820 offenders were discharged from Probation or Parole. Of those discharged Probationers and Parolees, 884 (48.57%) met all the requirements established by the courts to qualify as a successful discharge.

The felony offenders released in 2008, the percentage re-incarcerated within three years of release was 49.42%. This is a slight decrease from 2007 where 50.57% of the released offenders were re-incarcerated.

Reformative Programs

- The number of offenders completing an institutional or community based substance abuse treatment program increased from 424 in FY2010 to 719 in FY2011.
- The number of sex offenders that received a polygraph while on probation increased from 383 in FY2010 to 454 in FY2011.
- The number of offenders receiving a General Education Development (GED) certificate while incarcerated increased from 247 in FY2011 to 254 in FY2011.
- The number of offenders completing an institutional faith-based re-habilitative program increased from 36 in FY2010 to 44 in FY2011.

Major Activities to Advance Strategies

- Expand education and substance abuse programs offered,
- Institute improved data collection and reporting in all areas,
- Institute tracking system to determine recidivism rate of offenders,
- Increase vocational education opportunities and job training in the institutions,
- Increase interventions and referrals to community based agencies, and
- Increase referrals to all agencies that provide assistance and guidance to released offenders.

Key Department Challenges

Secure Confinement:

- Upkeep and maintenance of aging correctional facilities,
- Network reliability and capacity with an out-dated infrastructure,
- Lack of an electronic system for inmate records,
- Delivery of essential mental health services to keep up with rise in acuity and increase in number of mentally ill who are being incarcerated,
- Containment of health care costs for an aging inmate population, increased chronic health conditions, and increased acute cases, and
- Management of fluctuating energy costs for heating oil, natural gas, and electricity; and the subsequent impact on commodity costs (food, medical supplies, etc).

Supervised Release:

- Increased number of applicants for special medical, discretionary, and early parole termination,
- Transitioning of offenders from institutional treatment programs to limited community based treatment options and referrals, including community residential center beds, sex offender management programs and treatment providers, and residential substance abuse after care programs,
- Providing orientation to both institutional and field probation officers to expand the number of applicants for housing assistance under the Tenant-Based Rental Assistance Program, and
- Application of technical assistance from the National Parole Resource Center to develop a strategic plan for best practices in setting parole conditions, streamlining the violation and discretionary processes, obtaining a decision-making matrix, and use of assessment tools to target the criminogenic needs of the parolees.

Reformative Programs:

- Providing habilitative programs that aid offenders in successful re-entry into Alaska's communities and
- Development and modification of sex offender programs using recognized evidence-based practices in the

field of sex offender management in both institutional and community settings, including community safety, victim orientation, offender accountability, structure and consistency, quality control, and collaboration with other disciplines and entities.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013

The most significant change in FY2013 is the opening of the Goose Creek Correctional Center, the largest correctional facility in Alaska. Phased recruitment and training of correctional officers, probation officers, medical staff, program staff, and support staff, securing and facilitating air transports transitioning inmates from Colorado to Alaska, ground transports for property transition, and population management by classification will occur statewide in an effort to house offenders in the most suitable institution and geographic area.

An additional change is the implementation of an Institutional Sex Offender Management Program within the 3rd Judicial District (MatSu area) to support the offender population needs. The Department of Corrections (DOC) is expanding the residential sex offender treatment program currently in place at Lemon Creek Correctional Center (LCCC) to the 3rd Judicial District. This expanded program will implement a therapeutic residential sex offender treatment program for approximately 30 offenders. The DOC currently incarcerates over 600 medium and minimum security convicted sex offenders at any given time during the year. However, the only opportunity for sex offender treatment while incarcerated is currently in Southeast Alaska at LCCC. Due to the limited institutional treatment capacity, the majority of these convicted sex offenders will be released into their community with no tools or skills to avoid a possible re-offense. Results of the program will be measured through data collection on those who successfully complete the program versus the re-offense rate of a control group. The Department of Corrections will measure the outcomes by data analysis and long-term monitoring of the offender following the completion of treatment for re-arrests and re-offending.

Major Department Accomplishments in 2011

Secure Confinement:

- Construction of Goose Creek Correctional Center, under budget and ahead of schedule,
- Replacement of 1966 steam boiler and distribution system at Fairbanks Correctional Center, and
- Full revision of the department's classification and re-entry policies with full implementation scheduled for January, 2012.

Supervised Release:

- Expansion of available beds in community residential centers (half-way houses), a cost-effective population management tool,
- Expansion of the Anchorage Prisoner Accountability with Certain Enforcement (PACE) program,
- Published and distributed Alaska's 5-year Strategic Prisoner Re-Entry Plan,
- Partnered with the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) and the Alaska Board of Parole to develop and implement the Tenant-Based Rental Assistance Program to provide housing assistance for eligible tenants to enhance their successful community re-entry from incarceration.

Reformative Programs:

- Expanded services to provide extensive polygraph testing in all probation and parole offices statewide which allows every office to conduct testing at least twice a year,
- Increased vocational education programs within various correctional facilities,
- Increased institution and community based substance abuse treatment services, including assessment and referral services.
- Opened a new 36-bed sub-acute unit at the Anchorage Correctional Complex, and
- Spring Creek Correctional Center expantion of the sub-acute unit, which allows the department to provide for two levels of sub-acute care with varying degrees of supervision and structure for those inmates who still are unable to safely function.
