Component: Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA)

Contribution to Department's Mission

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) component prevents and eliminates discrimination against people with disabilities in employment and public services in state government, and establishes policies, guidelines and procedures for state agencies to follow to ensure compliance with Title I and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 as amended, and their implementing regulations.

Core Services

- Oversee the process of bringing the executive branch of state government into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- Monitor compliance efforts.
- Process complaints regarding the Americans with Disability Act.
- Oversee removal of architectural barriers in state facilities.
- Provide training to state employees on disability-related laws and resources consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Key Component Challenges

The key challenge facing the component is to effectively implement new rules with systems that support compliance with regulatory changes, especially in the areas of employee training, facilities access, website access, and reasonable accommodations.

The new regulatory changes include:

- 2010 Standards for Accessible Design
- Final Rule Implementing the ADA Amendments Act of 2008
- Revised ADA Regulations Implementing Title II and Title III
- Accessibility of Passenger Vessels
- Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008
- Proposed Guidelines for Public Rights-of-Way (comment)
- Draft Final Accessibility Guidelines for Outdoor Developed Areas

While Administrative Order 129 requires training for all executive branch employees regarding their obligations under the ADA, it is a challenge to ensure that the appropriate training is being provided. The program will propose expanded use of online options, and provide a forum for statewide collaboration at the biennial Access Conference.

The 2010 Standards for Accessible Design triggered the need for review of facilities to make sure programs are readily accessible and usable by people with disabilities. Plans for barrier removal need to be updated with the current standards, and include alternate access to programs where facilities are inaccessible. Agencies will need to develop transition plans for new types of facilities, such as swimming pools, boating facilities and fishing piers.

The ADA program is continuing its Web Access Project to provide greater usability of online information and services. Statewide policy will facilitate the use of standards by all employees that design websites and develop content for use electronically.

Because of broader coverage under the ADA Amendments Act of 2008 more employees and the public will qualify to receive reasonable accommodations or modifications. Updated policy guidance will reinforce this process especially tracking, confidentiality, and denials of requests. Centralized means of providing reasonable accommodations and modifications, including the use of assistive technologies, will be considered. The program will help agencies establish internal procedures to facilitate accommodations that enhance productivity and reduce costs.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013

No significant changes in results are anticipated.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2011

During FY2011, the component:

- Conducted the first biennial Access Conference. The 2010 Access Conference provided a forum for access
 and compliance issues, and how to implement the latest tools and standards. It brought together diverse
 groups of professionals, public and private agencies, compliance officers, and members of the disability
 community. There were eight tracks, 64 sessions, five forums, and over 300 participants. Awards were given
 to professionals and businesses that exemplify excellence building design, recreation, housing design, and
 ADA coordination. Conference evaluations gave the highest rating and underscored the need for
 collaboration to effectively implement access standards.
- Adopted a single statewide standard for training and evaluation of websites for accessibility.
- Trained approximately 400 people in five locations throughout the year in disability etiquette, disability rights standards, accessibility for programs and facilities, and web access.
- Resolved seven written complaints alleging disability discrimination, down from 44 complaints in FY2010.
