Dear Finance Committee Co-Chairs,

Enclosed is the personal services transfer report for the second half of fiscal year 2013 (FY2013). From January through June 2013, a net of \$27,867.2 was transferred from the personal services line. With the transfers of \$3,986.7 in the first half of FY2013, the total FY2013 transferred was \$31,853.9 for FY2013, or 1.3 percent of the \$2,363,145.7 personal service authorization.

The enclosed report details the transfers to and from the personal services lines for the executive branch agencies.

The transfers reflect the allocation of resources needed to accomplish the organizations' responsibilities. The reasons for the transfers vary and include:

- Adjustments to reflect updated staffing costs and other costs
- Transfers to correct line items allocations
- Transfers to align with the terms of specific grants
