Component Budget Summary

Component: Northern Region Highways and Aviation

Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide an efficient transportation system for the safe movement of people and goods, the delivery of state services, and the protection of the DOT&PF infrastructure.

Core Services

- Operate, maintain, and repair 8,850 lane-miles of roads, 1,550 lane-miles of aviation-operation surfaces at 104 airports, and 376 bridges.
- Control winter snow and ice: snow plowing, snow removal, sanding, de-icing, avalanche and drifting control, ice
 paving, snow fencing, and culvert thawing. Provide an active avalanche prevention and response program.
 Provide regional winter road and weather reporting on the Internet via the Alaskan "511/CARS" (road condition
 reporting) system, and through e-mails or faxes to state troopers, trucking firms, and others.
- Perform summer road and airport maintenance including: grading, pothole patching, crack sealing, leveling of pavement heaves and dips, brush clearing, street sweeping, dust control, drainage cleaning and repair, erosion control, bike path maintenance, fence and guardrail repair, bridge painting and repair, and sign maintenance.
- Maintain road and airport lighting systems: maintenance of traffic signals, intersection and road illumination, runway and taxiway lights, beacons, segmented circles and wind cones.
- Provide emergency response to both man-made and natural disasters in order to keep our transportation infrastructure both intact and safe.
- Control roadside litter and perform trash removal at rest areas, turnouts and campgrounds.
- Control encroachments on driveways, access roads, signs, utilities, and other state rights-of-way.
- Safely maintain and operate 104 state-owned certificated and non-certificated airports in compliance with state
 and federal regulations. This includes maintaining security at state airports through access controls, criminal
 history checks and badging of those with access to restricted areas, security fencing, communications and law
 enforcement. Provide Airport Rescue and Firefighting services at six certificated airports.
- Manage the Northern Region Adopt-a-Highway system.

Key Component Challenges

- Keeping existing road and airport systems in serviceable condition, enabling safe, efficient travel, despite
 aging infrastructure and the ravages of weather and climate change. The frequency of summer floods,
 coastal erosion, and forest fires seem to be increasing, which requires us to mount significant repair
 operations somewhere in the region every year.
- The annual summer program of transportation system repairs is becoming more difficult as existing aggregate material sites are depleted. Current environmental standards make the permitting of replacement sites expensive and time-consuming, and land available for new sites more scarce.
- Increasing unit costs for commodities and a slowly increasing budget has resulted in a reduction in the total battery of transportation infrastructure repairs being accomplished each summer.
- Recruitment and retention of operators, foremen and Superintendents has become more challenging due to the short supply, but high demand, for skilled maintenance personnel. Our Workforce Development is not keeping pace with the lure of private sector jobs. State wages and benefits are less attractive now than in the past, and it is hard to fill positions at our more remote, rural stations.
- Responding to continuing increases in security, documentation and access control, as required by FAA and TSA at certificated airports, has required additional time and funding.
- New federal environmental mandates and programs have dramatically complicated maintenance efforts, and increased the paperwork and documentation necessary to meet our responsibilities. Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasure (SPCC), Particulate Matter (PM-2.5 and PM-10), spill response and modern occupational safety constraints require significant training, equipment, paperwork and attention that impacts Maintenance & Operation's (M&O's) net productivity.
- Our efforts to introduce ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel to our rural stations and airports are meeting some
 resistance and complications, requiring expenditures for new equipment, tankage and unduly increased cost
 per gallon of fuel.

Increased equipment replacement costs resulting from tightened EPA emissions regulations and an increase
in the prices of fuel and steel has dramatically increased the cost of heavy equipment over the past 5 years.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2013

Initiating an inventory and assessment program, similar to our newly developed sign inventory program, for the Department's extensive culvert system. These are the first major steps toward implementation of an Asset Management system, to optimize infrastructure maintenance and control/reduce life-cycle costs.

M&O is beginning to develop a process to evaluate our existing material sites and determine which ones will require a SWPPP under the Department of Environmental Conservation's Multi-Sector General Permit. The development and administration of these SWPPPs is newly required by the EPA, and crucial to full compliance with the Clean Water Act.

Northern Region H&A will initiate an annual Culvert Flushing Program during FY13. This will better assure minimal sedimentation of effluent storm water flows from our Fairbanks storm sewer system, and provide sufficient storm/water storage capacity to avoid damage during heavy rain or flood events that would otherwise overtop our system.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2011

- Applied chip seal, hot mix asphalt paving, or high float surfacing to 157 lane miles of paved roads and highways, essentially returning 1,309 centerline miles of highway to significantly better service condition, throughout the region.
- Applied approximately 151,000 linear feet of surface crack sealing, and did 765,000 square feet of surface crack banding, which resulted in the protection of 481 centerline miles of roadway from water intrusion and freeze/thaw damage.
- Applied dust palliative products to the runways, taxiways, and aprons of eight rural airports: Buckland,
 Hughes, Kantishna, Kotzebue, Noatak, Russian Mission, Noorvik, and White Mountain. Aided local residents
 with a special dust control project for village roads at four Western sites: Buckland, Ambler, Noatak and St.
 Marys.
- Cut approximately 3,092 lane miles of brush and trees along our highways, side roads, and bike path rightsof-way. Highways and Aviation staff used the services of Southeast Alaska Guidance Association (SAGA) to
 hand clear over 60 acres of roadside brush, much of it in difficult-to-access areas along interior and south
 central area roadways.
- During the 2011 construction season the Northern Region Bridge Maintenance crew performed work on 32 bridges. Repair tasks varied from re-sealing deck joints and chipping out back wall spalls to completely rebuilding steel slider joints in Petersburg. They removed log jams at 3 structures and removed more than 100 yards of windblown silt from the bridges on the Copper River Delta. Cleaned the lower chords and connection plates on 9 bridges prior to fracture critical inspections by Bridge Design. On 21 other bridges, assisted Bridge Design with their inspection work. Our help ranged from traffic control to assisting with our under-bridge platform trailers.
- As a result of one of these routine bridge inspections, it was found that the Livengood Bridge had a severely damaged stringer and would have to be assigned a radically reduced service loading. This new service loading was inadequate to sufficiently support the Department's winter maintenance equipment, which is used to maintain the Elliott Highway. A decision was made to replace the damaged bridge with a temporary bridge, which was accomplished during the September using a temporary (emergency) bridge, in storage at Fairbanks. A permanent reconstruction project is under way, scheduled to replace the Livengood Bridge in approx. 2-3 years.
- Re-striped 3,465 lane-miles of highways across the Northern Region.
- State DOT&PF personnel replaced 39 small diameter culverts throughout the Northern Region and performed simple, periodic maintenance on 1,355 other drainage structures. This maintenance work included installation of thaw pipes, installation of culvert markers, cleaning of debris from structures, minor ditch activities, removal of various beaver dams, and repair and or replacement of damaged culvert inlets/outlets and band connection failures.
- Performed 9,355 linear feet of repairs to guardrail, fencing, and barriers. Installed, replaced, and/or corrected the height of 8,159 linear feet of existing guardrail as safety enhancement for the traveling public.

- Responded to, and cleaned up 14 avalanches in the Thompson Pass area on the Richardson Highway, as well as 20 avalanches in the Atigun Pass area, impacting traffic on the Dalton Highway.
- Developed and implemented 11 aggregate crushing contracts, which produced over 195,000 cubic yards of stockpiled aggregate material for current and future roadway surfacing repair efforts during both federal and state projects.
- Designed, advertised, and awarded one embankment stabilization project at MP 17 on the Tok Cutoff. This
 project consisted of utilizing a new foam injection technology which will fill voids in the roadway embankment
 with foam and provide a stabilized embankment.
- Completed repair of a 12' diameter multi-plate culvert located along the Glenn Highway which was damaged during this year's spring break up. This repair included removing a portion of the bottom of the culvert (26' long) and placing 28 cubic yards of concrete to prevent further undermining of the culvert and potential failure next spring.
- Designed, advertised, and administered construction activities to reconstruct Steele Creek Road, in Fairbanks. This 2.5 mile project consisted of drainage improvements, grade raises, and the paving of this previously gravel-surfaced major collector road.
- Completed contract administration/oversight on the Atigun Pass Guardrail Project. This project began
 construction in 2010 and was completed during summer 2011. It culminated the installation of over 20,000
 linear feet of box beam guardrail at Atigun Pass. The existing W-beam guardrail was in need of complete
 replacement and box beam was selected in order to better combat the constantly drifting snow at this
 location.
- Hired (3) non-perm personnel during summer 2011 and completed the remaining 1/3 of our regionwide Traffic Sign Inventory. This inventory is approximately 95% complete with only a few remote rural locations not yet surveyed. The final recorded data set shows over 44,000 signs in place along our 3,550 centerline miles of NR roads.

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Pursuant to Sec 21 Ch 3 FSSLA 2011 pg 76 In 19 through pg 78 In 27, \$18.0 million is distributed in August to State agencies from the Office of the Governor to offset the increased costs for fuel and utilities. Per the Department of Revenue (DOR), the fiscal year-to-date average price of Alaska North Slope crude as of August 1, 2011, was \$114.08 per barrel, which is \$19.38 (20.5%) above DOR's Spring 2011 FY2012 forecast amount of \$94.70.

The amounts transferred to state agencies are as follows:

Administration, \$27.3; Corrections, \$720.0; DEED, \$68.6; DEC, \$90.3; Fish and Game, \$93.2; HSS, \$720.0; Labor, \$42.4; DMVA, \$392.8; DNR, \$81.7; DPS, \$328.6; Transportation, \$13,455.1; University, \$1,980.0.

The \$13,455.1 transferred to DOT&PF was further allocated as follows: Central Region Facilities, \$460.0; Northern Region Facilities, \$1,107.7; Southeast Region Facilities, \$110.0; Central Region Highways & Aviation, \$565.0; Northern Region Highways & Aviation, \$1,500.0; Southeast Region Highways & Aviation, \$200.0; Marine Vessel Operations, \$600.0; Marine Shore Operations, \$170.0; Marine Vessel Fuel, \$8,742.4.

Historically, there has never been any requirement for insurances in the rural airport maintenance contracts as the Division of Risk Management determined rural contractors were covered under the State's accident umbrella.

Travel

Recently a change of ideology has occurred resulting in cost increases to the contracts. All airport maintenance contracts are now required to obtain insurances in new re-bids for contracts that will expire in FY2012. Insurance requirements for Rural Airport Contractors include: Workers' Compensation, Commercial General Liability Insurance and Automobile Liability Insurance.

Northern Region is currently funded for \$1,882.3 for 59 rural airport maintenance contracts. Final costs for FY2011 for these contracts were \$1,921.8 leaving us \$39.5 short funded. Total costs for these contracts for FY2012 are \$2,125.9, a shortage of \$243.6 for the year. For FY2013, we are estimating an additional \$180.0 for those renewing that year for a total need of \$423.6 in added funding.

There are at least two reasons for this large increase over last year. Contractors are asking for increases to their contracts as airports are enlarged or because as Alaska's CPI rises, costs in rural Alaska are increasing also. The second major reason for this increase is Risk Management and Statewide Contracts have issued guidance stating all new bids shall contain the insurance requirements for these rural airport contracts. Requiring the insurances by private, local rural contractors will increase the contract costs dramatically.

There were 12 contracts that renewed at the beginning of FY12 at an average increase of \$15.0 per airport due to the insurance requirement. We expect that many to renew in FY13 as current contracts expire. In future years, there will be approximately 12 contracts renewing each year so there will be more increases each year. An increment in funding is requested to meet this need so as not to impact other needs in the region that would affect our level of service provided to
